### KEVIN DEYOUNG

Kevin DeYoung (MDiv, Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary) is senior pastor at *University Reformed Church* in East Lansing, Michigan. He blogs at the *Gospel Coalition* and has authored or coauthored numerous well-known books. He and his wife Trisha have six children.

### WILLIAM TAYLOR

William Taylor is the Rector at *St. Helen's, Bishopsgate*, a church located in the heart of the financial district of London. He is part of a network in Great Britain that offers bible-centered training for young Christians. He is married to Janet and they have three children.

Stephen Nichols (PhD, Westminster Theological Seminary) is president of *Reformation Bible College* and chief academic officer of *Ligonier Ministries*. Previously, he served as research professor of Christianity and culture at *Lancaster Bible College*. He is an editor (with Justin Taylor) of the *Theologians on the Christian Life* series and is the author of several books. He and his wife Heidi have three children.
