Mark Dever

Mark Dever is the senior pastor of the Capitol Hill Baptist Church in Washington, DC (USA) and president of 9Marks. He is the initiator of Together for the Gospel (T4G) and has written a number of books and articles.

Albert Mohler

Al Mohler is the president of the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, KY (USA) and is a popular speaker and author. A co-founder of Together for the Gospel (T4G), he is also considered by Time Magazine and Christianity Today to be a leading intellectual amongst North American evangelicals.



Ligon Duncan

J. Ligon Duncan III is the chancellor of Reformed Theological Seminary (RTS) in Jackson, MS (USA), and holds the John R. Richardson professorship in Systematic and Historical Theology. He is also currently the

president of the Alliance of Confessing Evangelicals, besides serving on the council for The Gospel Coalition (TGC) and Together for the Gospel (T4G). Duncan has published over 35 books to date.

David Platt

David Platt is the president of the Southern Baptist Convention's International Mission Board and the director of Radical, an organization which promotes passionate evangelism and discipleship. Platt has become well-known primarily as an emphatic preacher of the gospel and author.
